SENIOR CLASS BULLETIN 2019

Regular classes are scheduled for seniors every day through Friday, May 17, 2019, until finals are over. Students are required to attend each class period each day of finals; NO EARLY Check-outs until all finals are completed. Office must have permission form signed by parent to leave early on final testing days. Teachers will test only during the period and date indicated on the schedule in fairness to senior students. Teachers will plan all classes accordingly.

All make-up work must be completed before May 8!

Diplomas will be issued on graduation day at the reception at CLCS along with awards. Therefore, it is important for seniors to make certain that financial obligations, all books, etc. are taken care of in order for the Administrator to have a diploma for each student on graduation day.

A Senior Student CHECKLIST For Diploma Release has been given to you. It must be signed by each faculty/staff member indicated and turned into the school office on Friday, May 17, 2019. Any outstanding obligation will cause a delay. **Failure to turn in the Check-Out sheet will result in having the diploma held and the senior not receiving it on graduation day.**

Senior LOCKER Check will be at 11:15am on Friday, May 17, 2019. You will need to have your locker cleaned out prior to 11:15am on May 19. **CHECKLIST sheet must be signed and turned in at this time.*

All students participating in Commencement exercises need to park at Cross Lanes Bible Church by 9:10am. A shuttle will run from church to school at 9:15am and back after grad. Be sure to have cap/gowns and tassel with you.

2019 Graduates are to be at Cross Lanes Bible Church by 9:10am with shuttle leaving promptly at 9:15am for CLCS.

Reception for all Seniors and their families to follow at CLCS MultiPurpose Room. You will receive your diploma and awards at the reception.

CONGRATULATIONS

GRADUATION DAY:

- 1) HATS: The shorter point in front should come directly between your eyes. The mortar board should be parallel to the floor NOT AT AN ANGLE.
- 2) GIRLS: Girls are to wear modest dress under their gown complying with school dress code. No strapless dress or spaghetti strap dress. The strap must be no less than 3 inches wide. No casual sandals. No backless shoes or flip flops. Meet in Ladies Gym Locker Room and wait to be summoned for ceremony to begin.
- 3) BOYS: Boys must have a clean shaven face and hair meeting school standards. Boys are to wear dark dress pants, shirt, tie dark socks, and black dress shoes. No tennis shoes or flip-flops. Meet in Mens Gym Locker Room and wait to be summoned for ceremony to begin.
- 4) Students who are inappropriately dressed will not march.
- 5) **Be at Cross Lanes Bible Church by 9:10am with your caps and gowns to promptly depart on shuttle at 9:15am to the school gym. No Cell Phones.**
- 6) Do not have gum. Do not run or talk loudly while in the recessional and waiting for ceremony to begin.
- 7) Graduation ceremony begins promptly at 11:00am.
- 8) Lottery drawing for reserved guest seating took place during bible class on April 9, 2019.
- 9) Once the graduation recessional is complete, make your way to the locker rooms to collect your belongings and proceed to the shuttle which will be parked in front of the pair of double doors on the side of gym. **DO NOT hang out in the gym lobby; let your guests greet you at the reception.**

REHEARSAL:

- 1) The only rehearsal for commencement will be at Cross Lanes Christian School on Friday, May 17, at 2:00pm.
- 2) If you expect to participate in the commencement exercises, you must be present for the rehearsal. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!

GENERAL:

- 1) Seniors will be dismissed at 11:15am on Friday, May 17.
- 2) Senior Class 2019 Drive-Off Campus will begin at 11:30am from the 100 building parking lot.
- 3) Seniors need to complete all of their obligations by that date.
- 4) Senior CHECKLIST for Diploma Release must be turned in by 11:15am after locker check on Friday, May 17.
- 5) If any senior has lost textbooks, owes a fee, or has any financial obligations, he/she must settle these matters before he/she can have his/her diploma.
- 6) The **Senior End of Year Check List** has been given to each senior. Each senior must have each faculty/teacher listed to sign off on this sheet that all obligations have been taken care of and all books returned to school. Complete check list must be returned to school office before Senior Drive-Off on Friday, May 17.

NO ONE WILL GRADUATE OWING DEBTS TO CLCS

IMPORTANT: If you have been accepted at more than one college, be sure to let each college know whether or not you plan to attend that school

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to request that a final transcript be sent to the college you plan to attend. **If you do not submit a "Transcript Request Form", a transcript will not be sent out.** No transcript will be sent until you have taken care of all obligations and fees.

Please remember and remind your parents and family that Commencement is a formal and solemn ceremony. The use of cell phones, air horns, etc is strictly forbidden.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

Each senior must meet the graduation requirements of 28 credits in order to participate in commencement ceremony. **Seniors who have not earned the required credits for graduation must complete them before a diploma will be issued.**
