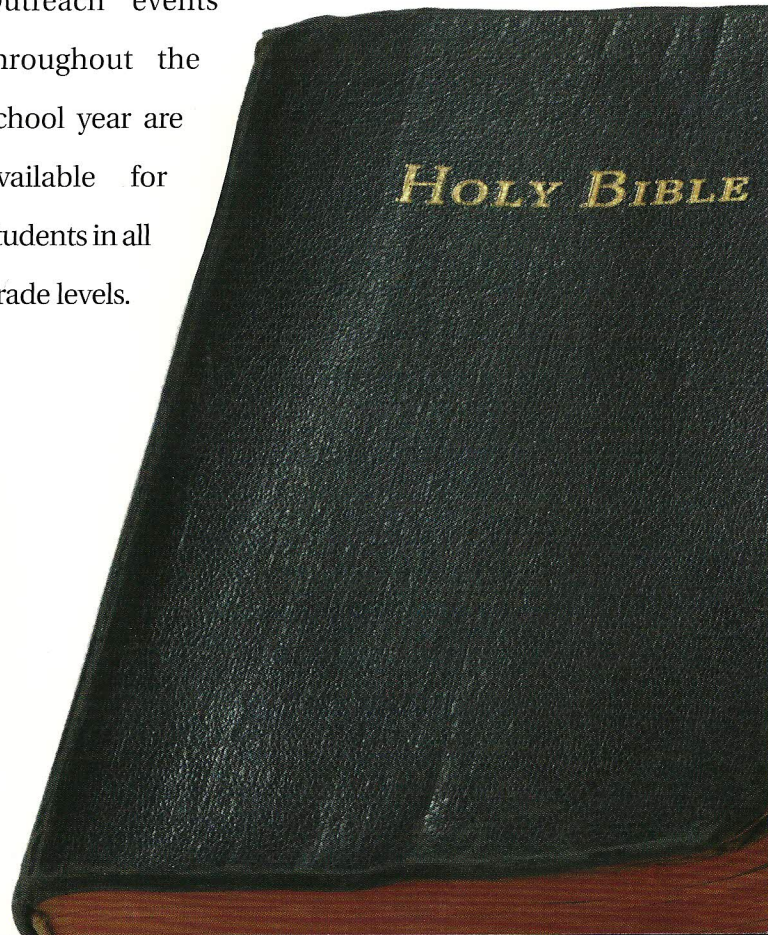

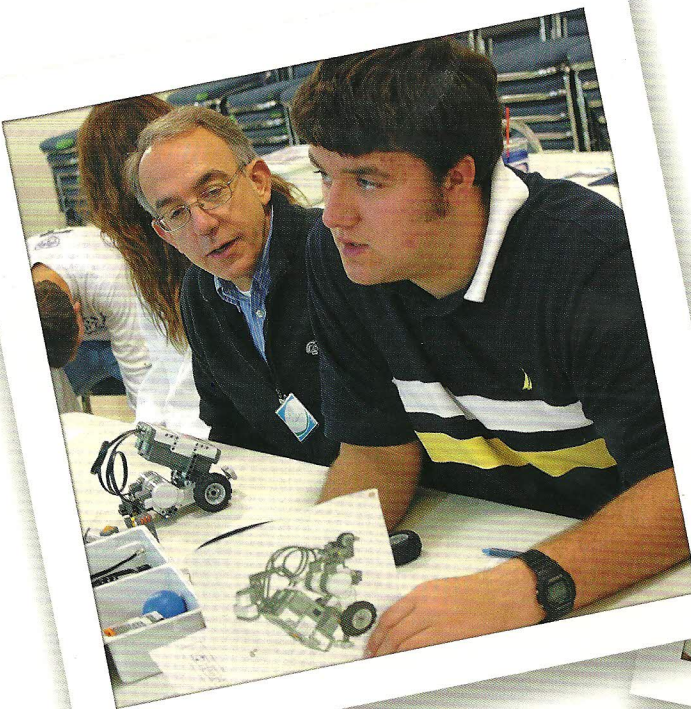

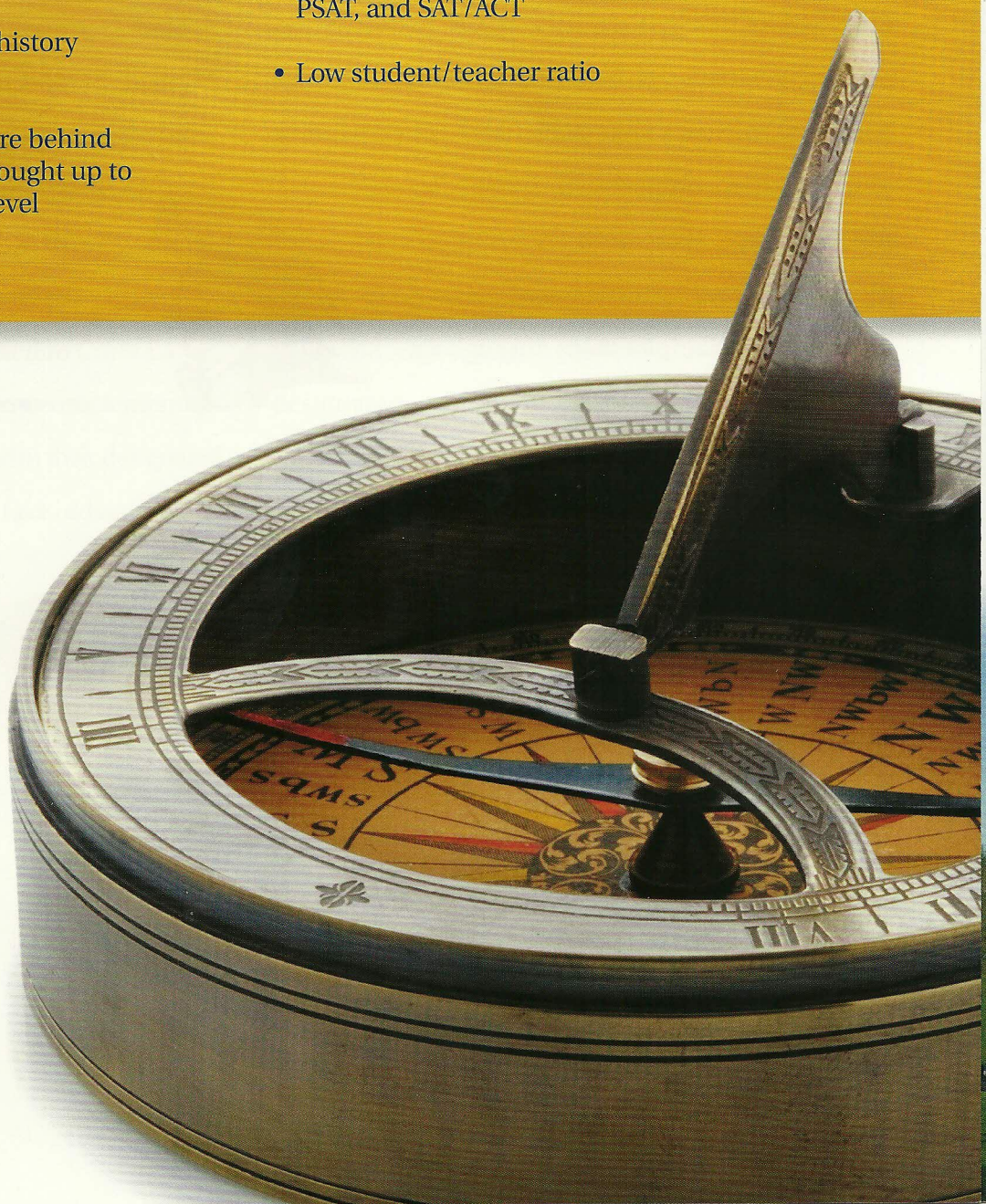
Cross Lanes Christian School's academic program offers a well rounded education for students which prepares them for college and their careers. Cross Lanes Christian School also offers an online service

which provides access to lesson plans, class room assignments, and test scores to the parents of students so they can keep track of the progress of their child's education.



Some highlights and achievements of the academic program include:

- More than 95% of students are reading by the first grade
- More than 90% of all graduating students attend college
- Average test scores higher than public schools as well as other private schools in Chemistry, Math, West Virginia History, and ACT tests
- Exceptionally strong math, history and science courses
- Transferring students that are behind academically are quickly brought up to the appropriate academic level
- High success rate at major public universities such as WVU, Notre Dame, etc.
- Many proceed into the medical profession
- Fine Arts program that includes band, choir, theater and individual competitions
- Above average test scores with SAT 10, PSAT, and SAT/ACT

Cross Lanes Christian School is nestled on 42 acres in Cross Lanes, WV just minutes from I-64. CLCS offers facilities for Pre-K through 12th grade. 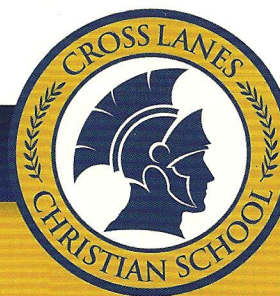
Frequently Asked Questions



- 1. IS THERE A SPECIFIC TIME OF THE YEAR THAT I CAN ENROLL MY CHILD AT CLCS?**
 - a. CLCS has enrollment open throughout the school year.
 - b. Most parents enroll their children the summer before school starts in the fall.
 - c. CLCS routinely gets transfers from other schools during the school year on a case-by-case basis.
 - d. We are equipped to make transfers and accept students at any time throughout the year.
- 2. WHAT IS THE ANNUAL COST OF ENROLLMENT?**
 - a. In your packet is included a rate overview for the upcoming school year.
 - b. Tuition is priced well below most private schools across the nation.
- 3. DO WE HAVE TO BUY BOOKS FOR OUR CHILDREN?**
 - a. There is an annual book fee - please see rate overview insert.
 - b. That fee includes all textbooks your child will use.
- 4. IS THERE A UNIFORM OR SPECIFIC DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS?**
 - a. Elementary students have school uniforms that include pants, shorts, and logo shirts.
 - b. Secondary students have a dress code that is outlined in the student handbook.
- 5. HOW ARE STUDENT TRANSFERS HANDLED?**
 - a. Contact CLCS to schedule a tour and receive an application
 - b. CLCS will need your student's transcripts from the most recent school year.
 - c. We can help you request those if you are unsure how to obtain a copy.
 - d. CLCS can make a transfer throughout the school year on a case-by-case basis.
- 6. DOES CLCS OFFER ANY PRE-K CLASSES?**
 - a. Yes, CLCS offers Pre-K classes through the Bright Beginnings Pre-school program at Cross Lanes Bible Church.
- 7. WHEN DOES THE SCHOOL YEAR TYPICALLY START AND END?**
 - a. CLCS typically follows the Kanawha County School calendar, but we make adjustments as deemed necessary.
 - b. CLCS students typically go to school more than the minimum 180 days Kanawha County requires, but due to our flexible calendar, students often finish their school year a few days earlier.
- 8. WHAT TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS ARE THERE FOR MY CHILD?**
 - a. CLCS offers full bus service in Kanawha and Putnam counties.
 - b. We have 4 complete routes available.
 - c. Contact the school office for current routes and pick-up/drop-off locations.
- 9. ARE THERE ANY AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS AT CLCS?**
 - a. Yes, aftercare is provided at a minimal cost per student.
- 10. WHAT ARE THE SPORTS PROGRAMS LIKE AT CLCS?**
 - a. CLCS offers sports for both middle school and high school
 - b. Girls and boys soccer, girls volleyball, girls and boys basketball, cheerleading and boys baseball are all available.
 - c. Student athletes have the ability to participate in state and national tournaments each year.
- 11. DOES CLCS OFFER FINE ARTS PROGRAMS?**
 - a. CLCS has children's choirs for all ages
 - b. Band is available for both elementary and secondary students.
 - c. Students participate in both state and national Fine Arts Competitions including choir, band, individual competitions, art, woodworking and photography.

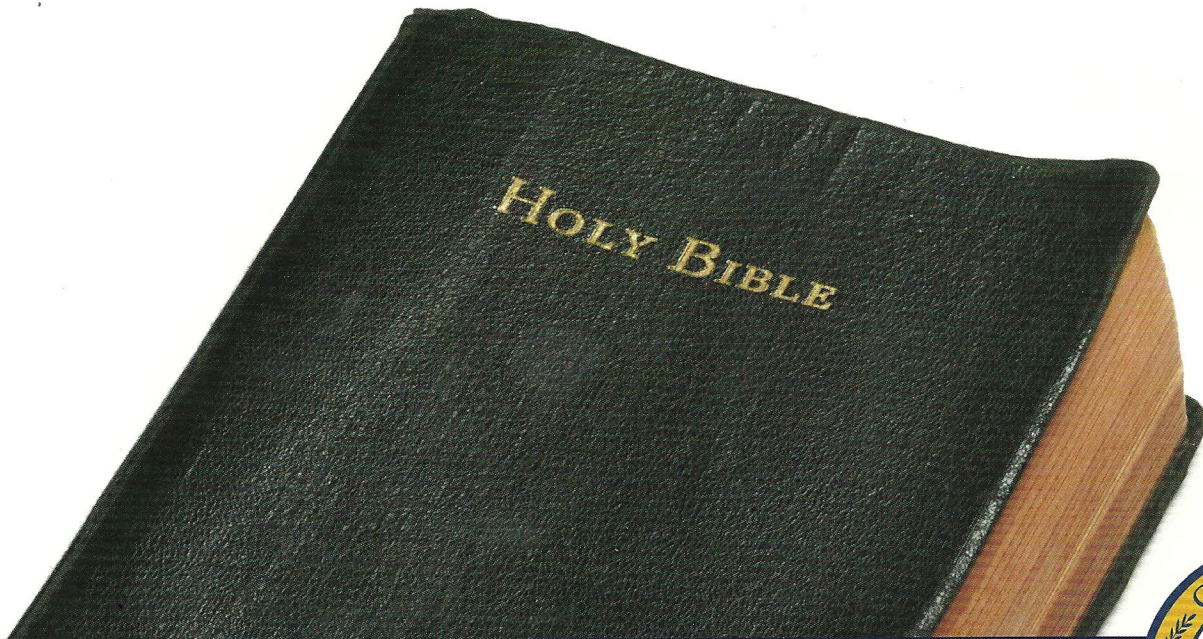




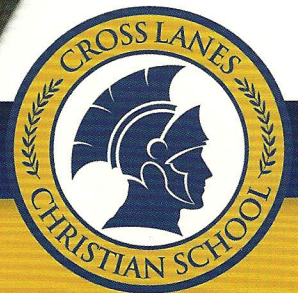
We are excited that you are considering CLCS for your child. While this information packet addresses many details and features of CLCS, we are certain you would like to know more.

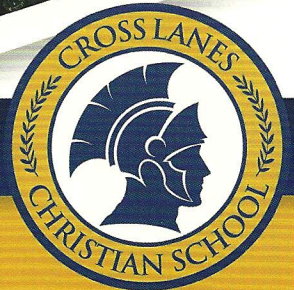


- Cross Lanes Christian School has some of the most experienced teachers in the Kanawha Valley.
